It can also be more difficult for people in the country to access essential medical services – including getting a heart health check and managing cardiovascular disease once diagnosed with it.

Nicknamed 'The Heart Bus', the rolling clinics have welcomed more than 2,000 patients, assisting those in communities presenting with critical, life-threatening symptoms. St Andrew's continues to strengthen its partnership with Heart of Australia to ensure people in the country have access to this vital medical service.
